Majors in AFRS complete a minimum of 30 credit hours in Africana Studies, including AFRS 1100, 3290, and 4000; and at least one of 2156, 2160, and 2161

Majors in AFRS-Concentration in Health and Environment complete a minimum of 30 credit hours in Africana Studies, including AFRS 1100, 2170, 3290, and 4000; at least one of 2156, 2160, and 2161; and a minimum of three of the following: 3155, 3250, 3261, 4630, 4640, and 4652.

Minors in AFRS complete a minimum of 18 credit hours in Africana Studies, AFRS 1100, 4010, six credits at the 2000 level, and six credits at the 3000/4000 levels.
